DIG DEEPER THIS WEEK:

We want to be an Army that praises God, shares God's goodness with others and always has new testimony of God's work in our lives. This is what this season of New Zeal is all about, and it begins with prayer. Join us in this pursuit over the next 5 weeks.

Take time to read Psalm 66:1-20

Verses 16-20 "Come and hear, all you who fear God; let me tell you what he has done for me. I cried out to him with my mouth; His praise was on my tongue. If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened; but God has surely listened and has heard my prayer. Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld his love from me!"

ASK YOURSELF THIS WEEK:

- > What might God be saying through this passage to you? To your corps/centre?
- > What can you praise God for this week? Where is God at work in your life?
- > How often do you share with others what God is doing in your life?

COVER IT IN PRAYER THIS WEEK:

Pray for opportunities to share with others what God is doing in your life.

Pray that God would use your story to impact the people around you.

Pray prayers of praise that He hears your prayers and has not 'withheld His love from us'.

BE INSPIRED THIS WEEK:
